Executive Summary:

World Orphanage Foundation helped a refugee camp in Parwan-e Do, Kabul. This donation was completed with the presence of Sara Kazimi the founder and CEO of World Orphanage Foundation. This donation contained food package distribution of bread, oil and sugar for 500 families in March 16, 2013.

Donation to Refugees:

One of the refugee camps of Kabul in Parwan-e Do was surveyed by World Orphanage Foundation team. They found out that refugees are in a bad condition that hardly they can afford their daily food. One of them that has been interviewed said: “It is difficult to find daily food, because there is no job, hardly I find 50 Afs (\$1) some days.” After knowing about this crucial situation of Afghan refugees, Sara Kazimi aimed to continue helps in Afghanistan.



On 16th March 2013, 500 refugee families were helped with food package of sugar, bread and oil. Sara Kazimi herself participated in the distribution of food packages with the rest of WOF team in the camp.



Conclusion:

World Orphanage Foundation helped 500 families in Kabul who were living in one of the refugee camps in Parwan-e Do. The food package contained of bread, sugar and oil that distributed with the presence of Sara Kazimi the founder and CEO of WOF.
